

Trade Area: Millhaven North - 30 minute Drivetime



## POPULATION

The population in this area is estimated to change from **112,556** to **113,268**, resulting in a growth of **0.6%** between 2010 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is projected to grow by **1.4%**.

The population in the base area is estimated to change from **308,745,538** to **325,139,271**, resulting in a growth of **5.3%** between 2010 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is projected to grow by **3.8%**.

The current year median age for this area is **34.2**, while the average age is **37.0**. Five years from now, the median age is projected to be **35.2**.

The current year median age for the base area is **38.2**, while the average age is **39.1**. Five years from now, the median age is projected to be **39.1**.

### Of this area's current year estimated population:

**45.7%** are White Alone, **50.4%** are Black or African American Alone, **0.3%** are American Indian and Alaska Nat. Alone, **1.0%** are Asian Alone, **0.0%** are Nat. Hawaiian and Other Pacific Isl. Alone, **1.0%** are Some Other Race, and **1.6%** are Two or More Races.

### Of the base area's current year estimated population:

**70.3%** are White Alone, **12.8%** are Black or African American Alone, **1.0%** are American Indian and Alaska Nat. Alone, **5.6%** are Asian Alone, **0.2%** are Nat. Hawaiian and Other Pacific Isl. Alone, **6.8%** are Some Other Race, and **3.4%** are Two or More Races.

This area's current estimated Hispanic or Latino population is **2.6%**, while the base area's current estimated Hispanic or Latino population is **18.0%**.



## HOUSEHOLD

The number of households in this area is estimated to change from **43,478** to **44,259**, resulting in an increase of **1.8%** between 2010 and the current year. Over the next five years, the number of households is projected to increase by **2.0%**.

The number of household in the base area is estimated to change from **116,716,292** to **123,356,629**, resulting in an increase of **5.7%** between 2010 and the current year. Over the next five years, the number of households is projected to increase by **4.0%**.
